From inside his fortified personality, Kisster manipulates abost of predatory characters, keeping at bay angels and vagrants in hisstruggle to survive.

In *Christ's Dog* the dying Lazar, arch-seducer and bigamist, treads out ajourney he feels compelled to undertake to reach accommodation withhis past. At every stage of his search, a different version of the untoldstory of Christ's dog is proposed to him. Lazar understands that hisseemingly worthless life – akin to the mongrel that howls at the foot of the cross – is a critical element of human morality.

Learning Kneeling is perhaps the most terrible of Barker's works, a playof apparently unredeemed extremity, relieved by a wit and a scrupulousintensity of thought that renders it a tribute to human persistence and imagination. Sturdee, a legless man of property, finds his home and his mistress seized by terrorists, the leader of whom, Demonstrator byname and instinct, leads him into a nightmare of ambiguities.
